The information that you are seeking is held by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Humberside. Please find our response below.

1) What was the cost of the Office of Police and Crime Commissioner in your police force area for the financial years 12/13 and 13/14?

During 2012/13 Humberside Police Authority was in existence from 1 April 2012 until 21 November 2012 when the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner came into existence. The total cost of the Police Authority/Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner in 2012/13 was £1.434m.

The provisional total cost of the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner in 2013/14 is £1.224m.
