Title: **Vulnerability Research Project**

Executive Summary: We receive monies from the MOJ annually to provide services to the victims of crime. It is widely recognised that vulnerable people have a higher chance of becoming a victim of crime. The OPCC has commissioned RSM UK Consulting LLP via a competitive process to undertake research to look at the relationship between vulnerability and becoming a victim. The final report (due Feb 18) will provide us with a Humberside profile of vulnerability and potential models that could benefit the people in our area in reducing the number of people becoming victims. This research will be used to inform our commissioning approach for victims in future years. Scoping exercises at procurement stage indicated that a budget of £40k was required for this work.

Decision: That RSM UK Consulting LLP be commissioned to conduct a research project to look at the relationship between vulnerability and becoming a victim, at a cost of £40,000.
