Thank you for your email of 30 April where you requested information about various travel costs within the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Humberside.

I can confirm that the information that you have requested is held by this office. Please find below our response to your questions as follows:

1. The total amount spent on taxis by the office of Humberside Police and Crime Commissioner since 16 November 2012 and details of these journeys.

No monies have been spent on taxis by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Humberside.

2. The cost of the most expensive taxi journey taken by Humberside Police and Crime Commissioner or a member of their office and the details and purpose of this journey.
