

Dear , thank you for your Freedom of Information request -

1. In the financial years 2013-2014, 2014-15 and 2015 - present, how many grants were awarded in which at least one of the outputs/outcomes was to provide services to victims of stalking? This could be any service to help victims e.g. counselling, information and advice, casework however the outcome must have specifically referred to working with victims of stalking.

1a. How many of these grants were towards work which was open to victims of stalking who were **not** being targeted by an ex-partner?

b) 2. What was the total monetary value of these grants?

c) 3. Which organisations were they awarded

The Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Humberside has not provided any grants where an output/outcome specifically referred to working with victims of stalking.

Funding of £535,000 was made to Victim Support in 2015/16 and would cover stalking as it is a crime, however the outcome was not specifically to deal with stalking and would therefore fall outside of your request. In addition monies have been allocated to a domestic abuse service which may include stalking but again was not a specific outcome.

As the PCC did not assume responsibility for victim services until April 2015 there is nothing to report prior to this.
